2017 CONVENOR'S REPORT

Conservation Priorities Plan

Grasswrens since 2006 – successful crowdfunding camping raised over \$14,000 had support of Southern Gulf NRM, TOs, Steve Murphy, and volunteers. Sound recorders installed and influencing fire management regime. Success is due to the vision and leadership of GH.

Beach-stone Curlew Surveys

Under leadership of Amanda Freeman survey of over 250 kms of coastline surveyed in 2000. A follow up survey will be repeated in March 2018 coordinated by CP and assisted by TC. Basis of bi-annual surveyed coordinated with BLA. TO rangers and local councils will need to be involved to ensure success.

Altitudinal Species

Golden Bowerbirds and Tooth-billed Bowerbirds. 30 people volunteered for transect surveys in 2017, conducted between 750m ASL to 1120m ASL. Surveys designed and coordinated by GH. Dominic Chapman undertook surveys further a-field in historical ranges. 520 TBB and 150 GBB recorded in the baseline surveys.

Communications and Marketing

Keeping members informed, general public, and local council. Who? What? How? Working group meeting to deliver project objectives (RC, TC, SW, MW, CP). BLNQ website under development in 2018.
